See something phishy? Take five and think!



Stop

Keep your information safe from criminals. Take a second to verify that the email you're looking at is legitimate, before you click on links.



Challenge

Do you recognise the sender? It's ok to reject, refuse or ignore any requests you are unsure about. Only criminals will try to rush or panic you.



Protect

If you think the email is a scam, report it to the National Cyber Security Centre by forwarding the email to report@phishing.gov.uk.

If you live in Scotland, call Police Scotland on **101**.
